ORGANIC FARMING (NATIONAL HORTICULTURE MISSION)

In a view to develop the Organic farming method in the field of agriculture PRAZWALA is implementing project at Thuppadahally Grama Panchayath & Hire Emmiganur Grama Panchayaths in Holalakere Taluk of Chitradurga District with the Support of **National Horticulture Mission (NHM)**. Working for to reduce the Chemical, Fertilizer and convert to Organic Farming method with Participatory approach and conducted Gramasabha, Baseline Survey, Formation of Organic Farmers Group, Trainings, Construction of Organic manure units, Vermicompost Units. Group Certification, Storage of Organic Products and linkage with Market.



AGRO, HORTI AND FORESTRY PROGRAMME

We have taken up the activities like NABARD-WDF and SUJALA-II programs and actively involved in community mobilization, formation/strengthening of User Groups, SHGs, Watershed implementation Committee, Area Groups towards better implementation of the programs like Soil and water conservation, Horticulture, Forestry, Animal husbandry activities etc., Along with that the organization has also initiated activities like Total Sanitation, Raita Mitra and NREGA along with District administration. While implementing these programs the organization has given special focus on participation of community and



RAIN WATER HARVESTING PROGRAMME:

PRAZWALA has implemented Rain Water Harvesting Units for the recharging of Ground water level and water Management. And conducted awareness programme for rural people through the trainings, workshops, jatha, street plays.

BIO FUEL PLANTATION PROGRAM

With the coordination of Chitradurga District Administration & ZP-Davanagere in the programme of Hasiru Honnu, we are able to complete 100000 forestry seedlings plantation in farmer lands, Waste lands and also area covered under mines and their by avoid the environment imbalance.

COMMUNITY HEALTH & SANITATION ACTIVITIES

PRAZWALA organization has organized awareness training programmes and camps on Healthy and hygienic environment make the people live with self-respect. In this regard tree plantation, construction of toilets installation of non- formal energies (solar system). In addition, We have organized 10 human and 52 animal Health camps. PRAZWALA has conducted Health Check-up camp and Animal Health camps, awareness programme conducted on Mother and Child Health, Immunization, Prevention of HIV/AIDS, Malaria, Polio, T.B with the support of NABARD, WDD, Local Health Departments and Doctors.
